The purpose of the CME program is to provide a forum through which educational needs are identified and assessed. Education is initiated and measurable improvement in practice occurs.

The content will support opportunities in patient care with educational updates specifically related to the community's assessed needs; updated educational focus on our current practice circumstances; as well as anticipating new directions in patient care.

Our target audience consists of the Medical Staff at St. Johns Regional Medical Center, St. Johns Pleasant Valley Hospital, physicians and Allied Health within our community. We target education for all specialties and sub-specialties as identified through the needs assessment process.

Our CME activities range from one-hour grand rounds to a one day symposia. The educational methodologies considered include interactive workshops, skill stations, case presentations, didactic lectures, panel discussions and question and answer periods. Educational activities are on site with the exception of a need for a larger conference space or a dinner outside the Hospital.
